In Key Stage 2 (years 3-6), if your child wears a shirt with a button up collar, they must also wear a tie. Please ensure that your child can do their own tie.



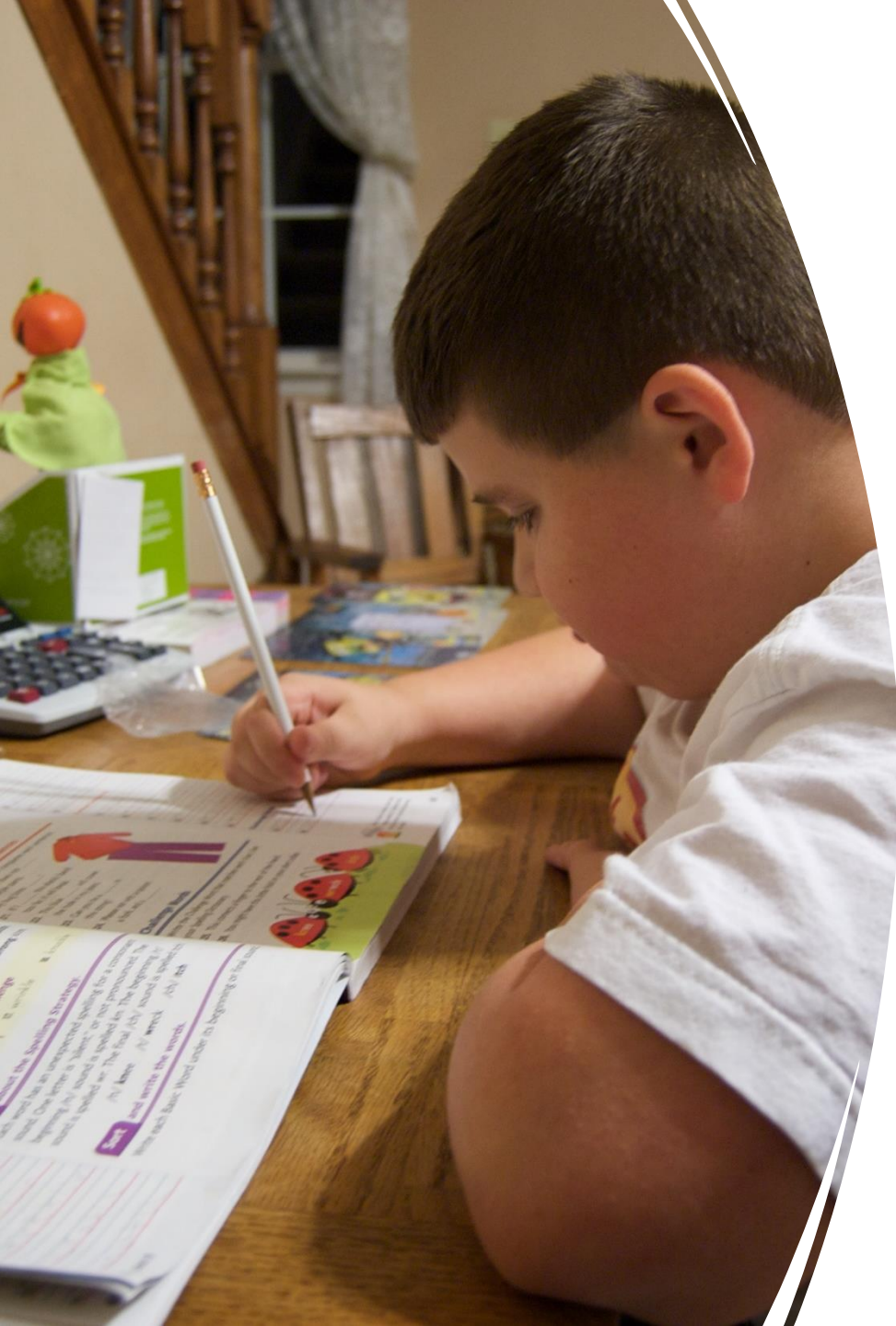
STATIONERY

HOMEWORK

Homework details will be found on the One Drive. It will include any links to resources that will help your child with their homework. The link to this can be found in the curriculum area of the school website.

- 2 pieces of homework will be set each week.
- They should take approximately 30 minutes each
- Homework will cover the following subjects: Maths and 'Mystery' (English/French/ science etc)
- We ask that children check their homework before Friday so that they can ask us for any help if needed.

HOMEWORK

Reading

- Reading should be completed every week-day night, recorded in their Reading Record. Your child must have three adult signatures each week in their Reading Record.

Spelling

- Spellings are set on a Friday and tested the following Friday. The class words will be put on OneDrive each Friday. Spelling logs need to be in school every day.

Times Tables

- Times tables will be set on TT Rockstars – 15 minute session that practises all the multiplication and division facts.
- Children will be tested on these weekly.
